

Goblin Washcloth

This pattern creates an adorably fierce washcloth. If you can cast on, knit, purl, and bind off, you have all the skills needed! The instructions are provided in both chart and row-by-row formats.

Finished Measurements

Worsted: 7.5" square; *Gauge:* 17 sts / 24 rows = 4 inches

DK: 6.5" square; *Gauge:* 21 sts / 31 rows = 4 inches

Materials

Yarn: 45 yards of cotton yarn in desired weight

Needles: US #5/3.75 mm needles for worsted weight yarn or US #4/3.5 mm needles for DK weight yarn; yarn needle

Chart

Right Side: Knit white stitches, purl green stitches.

Wrong Side: Knit green stitches, purl white stitches.

Instructions

Cast on 35 stitches, then either follow the chart or follow the row-by-row instructions below. (If you're using the instructions below, you may still find it helpful to use the chart as a reality check—just remember to read odd rows from the right and even rows from the left!)

Rows 1–5: Knit.

Row 6: K2, P 31, K2.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: K2, P2, K6, P4, K3, P4, K2, P3, K3, P4, K2.

Row 9: K5, P5, K2, P2, K4, P3, K4, P6, K4.

Row 10: K2, P2, K2, P7, K2, P1, K2, P3, K2, P6, K2, P2, K2.

Row 11: K4, P2, K6, P2, K3, P2, K1, P2, K7, P2, K4.

Row 12: K2, P3, K2, P5, K2, P3, K2, P2, K2, P6, K2, P2, K2.

Row 13: K5, P3, K4, P2, K2, P2, K3, P2, K4, P2, K6.

Row 14: K2, P5, K2, P3, K2, P3, K2, P2, K2, P4, K3, P3, K2.

Row 15: K4, P2, K6, P2, K2, P2, K3, P2, K2, P2, K8.

Row 16: K2, P2, K2, P2, K2, P3, K2, P1, K2, P3, K2, P6, K2, P2, K2.

Row 17: K4, P2, K6, P2, K3, P2, K1, P2, K3, P2, K2, P2, K4.

Row 18: K2, P3, K4, P5, K3, P4, K2, P2, K5, P3, K2.

Row 19: K6, P3, K3, P2, K4, P3, K6, P2, K6.

Row 20: K2, P31, K2.

Row 21: Knit.

Row 22: K2, P31, K2.

Row 23: Knit 14, P6, K15.

Row 24: K2, P11, K10, P10, K2.

Row 25: K11, P5, K3, P4, K12.

Row 26: K2, P10, K3, P5, K4, P9, K2.

Row 27: K10, P3, K8, P3, K11.

Row 28: K2, P8, K2, P11, K3, P7, K2.

Row 29: K8, P3, K7, P8, K9.

Row 30: K2, P5, K13, P4, K3, P6, K2.

Row 31: K8, P2, K2, P17, K6.

Row 32: K2, P3, K8, P3, K12, P5, K2.

Row 33: K7, P6, K3, P3, K3, P2, K1, P5, K5.

Row 34: K2, P2, K5, P2, K8, P3, K7, P4, K2.

Row 35: K6, P4, K1, P12, K5, P4, K3.

Row 36: K2, P1, K2, P7, K11, P3, K4, P3, K2.

Row 37: K5, P4, K4, P9, K9, P1, K3.

Row 38: K2, P13, K6, P6, K4, P2, K2.

Row 39: K4, P3, K28.

Row 40: K2, P27, K3, P1, K2.

Row 41: K3, P2, K30.

Row 42: K2, P29, K1, P1, K2.

Row 43: Knit.

Row 44: K2, P31, K2.

Rows 45–49: Knit.

Bind off and weave in trailing yarn.



Goblin Hat

This pattern requires the ability to knit in the round and the ability to do stranded colorwork.

Size

Infant (Cast on additional stitches and add rows to brim and above chart to reach the desired size—adult sizes would use 100–120 stitches and have a longer brim.)

Finished Measurements

Circumference: 14 inches; *Height:* 6 inches; *Gauge:* 20 sts / 24 rows = 4 inches

Materials

MC: 1 skein dark worsted weight yarn

CC: 1 skein green worsted weight yarn

Needles: 4 US #5/3.75 mm double pointed needles (adjust up or down to achieve gauge), yarn needle

Abbreviations

K2tog: Knit 2 stitches together (right-slanting decrease)

MC: Main color

CC: Contrast color

*: Repeat to end of row.

Instructions

Cast on 70 stitches.

Work K1, P1 ribbing until brim reaches desired length (1/2–1 inch).

Knit 2 rows.

Begin chart; knit the rest of each row as 39 MC stitches (carrying the CC behind).

Knit 2 rows.

Decrease Rows

Row 1: (K2tog, K5)* (60 sts remaining)

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: (K2tog, K4)* (50 sts remaining)

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: (K2tog, K3)* (40 sts remaining)

Row 6: Knit.

Row 7: (K2tog, K2)* (30 sts remaining)

Row 8: Knit.

Row 9: (K2tog, K1)* (20 sts remaining)

Row 10: Knit.

Row 11: (K2tog)* (10 sts remaining)

Bind off and weave in ends. Pom pom/tassel is optional!

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
